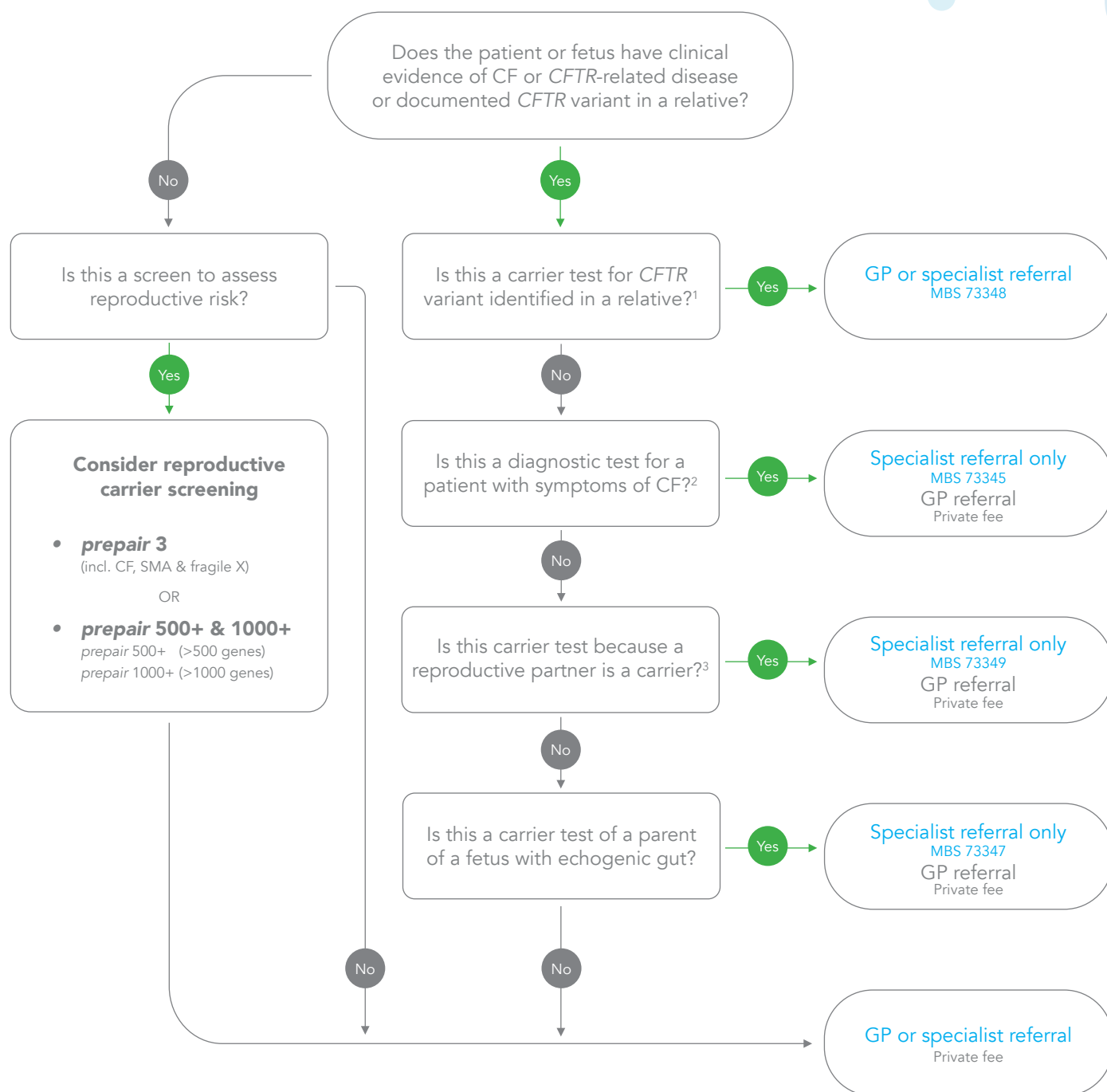


# Medicare rebates for *CFTR* testing



<sup>1</sup>To qualify for rebated cascade testing, the requesting practitioner must specify the family's reported pathogenic variant(s), and the risk of the patient being a carrier must be at least 6% (i.e. related to a known carrier as parent, child, full or half-sibling, grandparent, grandchild, aunt, uncle, first cousin, or first cousin once-removed. Testing of second cousin or more distant relationships is available for a private fee).

<sup>2</sup>Diagnostic testing includes testing of a patient with clinical feature suggestive of cystic fibrosis (CF), CF-related disease (*CFTR*-RD), or congenital bilateral absence of the vas deferens (CBAVD).

<sup>3</sup>Eligible for rebate if partner is a known carrier of a pathogenic *CFTR* variant(s)
